B. MONARCHY - The Rise and Decline of David's House - David to Jeconiah - Matt 1:1:6b-11

This second section recounts the history of Israel through it's monarchy from David down to Israel's exile to Babylon...a story of spiritual, political, and material decline.

C. HIERARCHY - - The Eclipse of David's House - Jeconiah - Joseph - Matthew 1:12-16

This third section takes the history from the Babylonian captivity (586 BC) to the birth of our LORD. The focus of this section will be verse 16..."And Jacob begot Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom (whom = feminine relative pronoun referring to Mary, not Joseph) was born Jesus, Who is called Christ."
