

# THE BIRTH OF THE MESSIAH - MIRACULOUS

Matthew 1:18-25 begins by telling us two great doctrinal truths. These two truths are picked up in the Apostle's Creed: "Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary." This morning we will not seek to explain things which are above our feeble mind. It is faith which pleases God and so let us be content to believe with reverence what God declares to be, and that with Him nothing is impossible. The Lord Jesus Christ took upon Himself our nature and became a man. This passage tells us that His birth was miraculous - His earthly mother was a virgin. We always speak of the "virgin birth" - in reality it was the "virgin conception".
