Nehemiah 1-13

Introduction Each father here this morning should understand the strong influence of what his children see in him and hear from him. What a child sees and hears from his father will have either a good influence or a bad influence upon that child. Children should see their fathers: - working – expressing emotions of love, affection, anger (godly anger), fear – worshipping at home and at church. Children should hear their fathers pray, read the Bible, extol the virtues of others, uphold the roles of leadership and authority – and children should hear their fathers openly and unashamedly condemn evil, injustice and wrong in the world. In our study on Nehemiah there is no indication that he was a married man but he was a man on a spiritual mission who exhibited certain exemplary qualities while accomplishing that mission. If you are a father here this morning – You are a man on a mission. What the people in Nehemiah’s day saw and heard in him should be what your sons and daughters see and hear in you.
