MOSES RETURNS TO EGYPT

Exodus 4:18-31

<u>INTRODUCTION</u> Forty years earlier Moses was sure that he could be Israel's emancipator; but now that God is calling and commissioning him he was sure that God had the wrong person, certain that no one would believe him. He could give no reasons for disobeying God but he certainly had plenty of excuses as we have seen. Billy Sunday once defined an excuse as the skin of a reason stuffed with a lie. In responding to the excuses of Moses God assured him that He would give him everything that he needed to accomplish the mission he was sending him on – He gave Moses a message and detailed instructions – He gave him powerful credentials to substantiate the message – He would also give him a companion. All that was necessary was for Moses to trust the great I AM Who was commissioning him.
