PROMISES, PROMISES - GOD'S ANSWER TO DISCOURAGEMENT

Exodus 6:1-13- (Continued from Sunday, February 3, 2019))

INTRODUCTION Though Pharaoh may swear up and down by his gods that he will not let the Children of Israel go in defiance of Yahweh's command, "Let My People go!" God has declared to Moses that Pharaoh "will drive them out of his land" (Exodus 6:1)...no ifs ands or buts about it. Wise indeed is the insight Arthur Pink gives us in his commentary on the Book of Exodus – "...in strengthening the heart of His servant the LORD pointed Moses forward to the goal...There was much that was to happen in between, but the LORD passes over all that would intervene, and speaks of the last act in the great drama which was just opening." In Exodus 6:1 God is assuring Moses that Pharaoh, the great enemy of His people would be utterly defeated. Pink then applies the passage to you and I here this morning: "We defeat ourselves by being occupied with the difficulties of the way. God has made know to us the triumphant outcome of good over evil, and instead of being harassed by the fiery darts which the Evil One now hurls against us, we ought to rest upon the assuring promise that 'the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly.'"
