## THE ROAD TO FREEDOM BEGINS WITH GOD

Exodus chapters 6 through 11 - (Continued from March 24, 2019)

INTRODUCTION: Seven plagues down — three to go. Once again Moses and Aaron confront Pharaoh — "...Let My people go, that they may serve Me." — Exodus 10:3. God's demand is consistent regardless of Pharaoh's response. It's the next two words of verse 4 that I for one often heard as a young child growing up — "Or else". I never had to ask "Or else what?" I had learned very early in life exactly what "Or else" meant — negotiations were off the table. For Pharaoh the "Or else" meant that an eighth plague of astronomical proportions was coming that would devour what was left after the plague of hail and fire — Exodus 10:4-6. One great lesson we can learn from Pharaoh is that God's sovereign will is not negotiable. Those who repeatedly oppose God will ultimately be broken as Pharaoh was. The road to true freedom in a person's life is to heed the "Or else" from God — and incredible as it may seem, the "Or else" leads to nothing but God's grace — His mercy — and His unending love in Christ.
